Captains suggestions and inputs for discussion:

- 1. Firstly, and Foremost, I would like to establish a season long points race. In this, I would like to convert the Closing Cup to the NATO Cup. My idea is to purchase a plate style trophy, with the NATO Emblem on it, where names can be engraved. You will see next to each event, a rough idea of points. I have designed the points around both participation and winning. Trophy events are worth more points, casual events less. The idea is to promote participation in events. Calculation of point throughout the year would begin with the Christmas Cracker each year, except this year where we would start with the Celtic Quaich.
 - a. Those events lined out, I have gotten reservations at the courses. Those in red are non-NGC events that we help promote. I do not yet have information on the Zodengham Open and not sure if we need to keep that one. Note each of those we promote, blocks us from a club event in that period.
 - b. I have not yet figured out how to break the blockage related to a Shape versus NGC event, as Shape seems to insist on playing on a Friday.
 - c. You will also see that I have predicted a certain events to be followed by dinner. I will look at tee times around this, though dinner may be a bit early.......
 - d. We now have the year scheduled out well in advance and up on the website, other than the couple of gaps I am working to fill.
 - i. This was suggestion was supported and we agreed to start the season long points race, and a trophy will be bought for this event.
- 2. As we are going to have a trophy case in the staff centre, eventually, I would really like to upgrade the look and quality of each of our trophies, with specific emphasis on the engraving of names. I think we can really show off our history, with our trophy display in the centre. Won't be seen by that many, but at least it is out there.
 - a. We agreed to take upgrade 2-3 trophies every year, this so we do not "break the bank"
- 3. I would like to put a little more of a write up on each event and its history. This would include a bit of a write up of the history of the Horton Cup and why we call it that. Within this, I'll work to establish a page on the website that lists each trophy event and the past winners and club officers.
 - a. Good idea that was supported. In the NGC 25th anniversary book, most of the data related to Club Officers can be found. We now have to make this info more available on the web page.
- 4. Based on feedback in discussions with a number of members I am providing a variety of formats in the events during the year. Non trophy events being a bit more social. We will have a mix of stroke play, scramble, match play and possibly others. May even introduce some skins. I believe we need to shake it up a bit. You will see my plan on formats in the attached.
 - a. We agreed to this suggestion, and this will be practised throughout the season.
- 5. Finally, like others, we need to make handicapping better. We need a transparent way to monitor handicaps that allows for continual update and ease of use for each member. The rigidity of the process for Belgium Clubs is not that helpful.

- 6. As I see it, we can do this in one of three ways.
 - a. 1. We install our own handicapping software. This will come with an investment. I have looked at a number of packages and they all cost about the same. This could range from \$200-\$400 USD per year. Its higher than I would prefer, but it is what it is. In all honesty, I do not see raising annual dues by 10 euro per year as unreasonable to make up for this. Note, this would include overseas members, as they can easily enter scores for any course they play in the world and receive an official USGA handicap card, through us.
 - b. There are a number of applications we could use. The best I am seeing so far it TheGrint. TheGrint would allow the same thing to occur, to include scheduling events. TheGint would allow us to form our own official club, everyone sign on to that club and see each other's scores. Members can still enter all rounds they play and maintain their handicap. The difference here is that each member would purchase their own copy of the application. Cost is roughly 20USD per year. The downfall is that it would be very difficult for us to require people to use it, as it would be an outside the club cost.
 - c. The final approach, as some has suggested is an internal club handicap. This one worries me, as it will be labour intensive and require an individual to track the results of each member who plays in each event. Coming up with a predictable and transparent formula I think would be difficult and lean to possible conflict. Tracking it will be laborious, and I fear very likely fall to the Captain to keep up with. I see this as the least viable option.
 - i. We agreed to do a 1 year trail with a handicap system that will cost around US \$275. After this trail we will have to re-evaluate if this filled the intention and provided sufficient benefits so that we would continue. Since this is trail period, we will not change the annual fee this year, this will be something that need to be decided for 2021.
